



Pre-planning is not always possible; do not fret we are here to assist you. If your wedding or other event has already occurred, you will need to act very quickly to save your flowers and get them to our specialists for preservation. It is best if we have your fresh flowers no later than three days after the event has taken place. In the case of fresh flowers, sooner is always better for the best possible results. If you are not certain if it is too late please give us a call at **1.847.776.9808** during usual business hours (10:00AM to 5:30 PM). Working together we will discuss your options and necessary steps.

Re-hydrate!!!! Re-hydrate!!!! That is the code word for saving your fresh event flowers. Keep your flowers cool, refrigerated if possible (do not freeze) and hydrated using fresh flower food, which can be provided by your florist until you pack them for shipping. If the stems are showing, you can trim the ends and put the bouquet in the treated water. If the flowers are in a bouquet holder, place the bouquet over a sink and pour a small amount of treated water into the center of the holder. Place the bouquet in the refrigerator until ready to pack for shipping.
